

Outstanding Nursing Support Award Local Award

Purpose: Presented in recognition of exceptional service and collaboration in a nursing support role while

demonstrating a positive attitude, professional standards and true concern for patients, families and fellow

caregivers.

Eligibility: Any clinical caregiver, excluding LPNs, RNs & APRNs, in Cleveland Clinic's Nursing Institute (e.g.,

nursing assistants, BH/ED/OR/nurse technicians, health unit coordinators/secretaires, medical

assistants). The nominee must have achieved "commendable" or higher at their last annual performance

review with no corrective action in the last two years.

Process: Any caregiver, patient or volunteer may nominate. Nominations will be scored during a double-blind

review based on evidence provided by completion of the nomination questions. Honorees will be

announced during Nurses Week.

Instructions: Please DO NOT use the nominee's name when writing details: Address as the NOMINEE. Please answer

each question completely, providing specific examples or descriptions as requested, including patient and

other caregiver comments. When possible, provide quantitative data to support examples.

1. Provide an example showing how the nominee participates in a collaborative effort of a group/team to achieve a common goal.

2. Provide an example showing how the nominee is open to change and looks for more efficient means of meeting goals. Describe how they implemented a new or improved service, process or practice.

- Describe how the nominee demonstrates excellence in interpersonal relationships through empathy, compassion, respect and true concern for patients, families and fellow caregivers that provides a caring and supportive environment.
- 4. Provide an example showing how the nominee serves as a role model by adhering to high moral principles and professional standards through positivity, honesty and integrity.
